Disaster Relief and Community Disaster Education

When a disaster threatens or strikes, the Red Cross is there. This year, we responded to **15** local disasters. Sadly, most are preventable residential fires. Our response included emergency food, shelter, clothing, and other necessities such as medications.

In addition, many of our **67** Disaster Action Team members worked on National Disaster Relief Operations including fires, floods, hurricanes and winter storms.

As a whole, we educated **723** people in basic disaster preparedness.

Health and Safety Services

From first aid, CPR and AED training to swimming and lifeguarding, American Red Cross programs help people lead safer and healthier lives. This year, **4,191** individuals learned life-saving skills through **545** classes offered by the Chapter, and **four** CPR/AED instructors were certified.



Services to Armed Forces (SAF)

The American Red Cross provided communication between those in the Armed Forces and their families. We have a worldwide network to reach service members wherever they are to communicate a birth, death or illness. This year, we provided briefings and emergency connections for **48** military families. Also, we collected over **1,100** pairs of socks for the local National Guard Units prior to their deployment.

Blood Services

Over the last year, we helped run **57** community blood drives, collecting **2,955** units of blood. There were **49** private business and campus blood drives. This number continues to grow. There were **648** first time donors.

International Services

Throughout the world, we support families separated or displaced by man-made or natural disasters.

Community Services

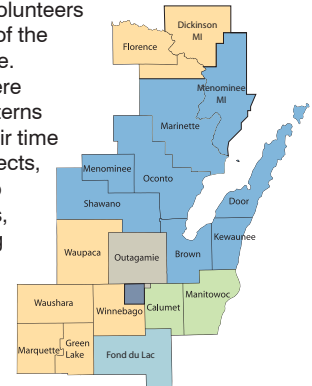
Our collegiate Red Cross Club at Ripon College has **10** members who serve as brand ambassadors on campus.

We depend on volunteers of all ages and backgrounds to carry on our work. Volunteers constitute **97** percent of our total workforce, serving as members of the board, instructors teaching lifesaving skills, disaster action team members, office administrators, event organizers and more.

This year, **533** volunteers made the work of the Chapter possible. Among them were **eight** college interns volunteering their time working on projects, such as, Dare to Prepare, Heroes, and our Evening Extraordinaire.
